## From Pastors Mark and Sandie Johnson



Dear Friends, It's the time of year that we like to settle down in the evening with a glass of eggnog and watch Christmas movies. After several years of movies, and many gallons of

eggnog, it seems like 90% or more of all Christmas movies include: a city slicker who travels to a picturesque small town a week before Christmas and meets a charming local. Besides the city slicker and the charming local there is a precocious child, a faithful dog, and a mysterious, but very wise, older person. The movie concludes with a Christmas tree lighting in the town square and caroling as a light snow falls. And, of course, the happy ending is credited to the true meaning of Christmas.

The Bible says the meaning of Christmas is something altogether different. John's Gospel shares: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being. What has come into being in him was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth." (John 1: 1-5, 14 NRSV)

Look again at the final verse: "... the Word became flesh and lived among us." The original Greek says "and he pitched his tent next to us." If we were to write a "Broncos Fan Version of the Bible" we might translate this "and the Word left the Owners Box and is hanging with the folks in the South Stands."

Theologians call this <u>incarnation</u> which means "embodied in flesh." For Christians, Christmas celebrates God's decision to step out of eternity and into history in the person of Jesus Christ. As a living breathing person, like you and me, Jesus experienced all that humans experience. And Jesus, fully divine, has the power and compassion to transform our lives. And in incredible grace, Jesus gave himself for us and was resurrected from the dead so all who believe in Him can have eternal life. But we're getting ahead of ourselves. Crucifixion and resurrection are the meaning of Easter story and the key word for Easter is <u>atonement</u>.

Pastor Sandi and I wish for each of you a Christmas season in which the true meaning of Christmas fills your lives. Almighty God incarnated in the person of Jesus has come into the world and into each of our lives that we might live lives of hope, faith, joy, and love. As the old Christmas carol proclaims,

"Veiled in flesh the God-head see; hail the incarnate Deity,

pleased with us in flesh to dwell, Jesus, our Emmanual.

Hark! The herald angels sing, "Glory to the newborn King!"

From our family to you and yours: Merry Christmas!

In December we'll meet in Fellowship Hall on December 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM for the annual soup and salad dinner.






