Dear Friends

As I write this note early on a Saturday morning, Sandie and I are getting ready to take a drive in the mountains to enjoy the Fall colors. Then we will probably work a while in the garden, harvesting the last corn, tomatoes and squash. And you know, dinner will be a feast of veggies fresh from the garden. It seems as if all of God's creation is coming to a beautiful climax and telling us "Winter is coming but remember, just remember, all the colors and glory of God's creation."

This is a good season for remembering. All Saints Sunday – when we celebrate the Saints of the church who have nurtured our faith – will be Sunday, Nov. 3. As a church we look back in thankfulness and commit to serving faithfully in the future because we know that God, who planted our church 150 years ago, still has marvelous plans for our future.

### **Photographer Needed for our Sesquicentennial Celebration**


